Dr. Vanessa LoBue, is an Associate Professor of Psychology at Rutgers University in Newark. She directs the Child Study Center and her research program investigates human behavioral responses to emotionally valenced stimuli—



specifically to negative or threatening stimuli—and the mechanisms guiding the development of these responses.

She received her B.S. from Carnegie Mellon University, and her M.A. and Ph.D. from the University of Virginia. After doing a post-doc at New York University, she joined the Rutgers University faculty in 2011.

In her research, Dr. LoBue is interested in emotional development, and the effect of emotion and experience on perception and learning.
